

## **LEAD CASE MANAGER**

The Taunton Housing Authority is seeking a highly motivated, organized, responsible individual to fill the full-time grant-funded position of Lead Case Manager for the HOPE VI Revitalization Program. The position will be responsible for the coordination and implementation of the Community Supportive Services and Relocation component of this initiative. In addition, this position will provide case management to residents via household assessments and service plans.

Minimum qualifications include: Bachelor's degree with five (5) years of progressive leadership experience working with families, youth, elders, and people with disabilities; a minimum of two of the five years with combined experience in social services delivery, program administration, and case management. Master of Social Work degree preferred. Excellent organizational, written, and oral communication skills required. Computer literacy required. Bilingual preferred. The ability to work in a public or affordable housing setting, and nights and weekends when needed is a necessity. Must possess a valid Massachusetts driver's license. Candidates will be subject to criminal background check and employment verification. A job-related physical and drug test will be required. The annual salary range for this full-time grant-funded position is \$50,000 to \$55,000 depending on experience including a competitive benefit package. Position shall remain open until filled.
